Interdepartmental with Family and Community Medicine and Internal Medicine and Neurology and Ophthalmology and Osteopathic Medicine and Pediatrics and Psychiatry. Administered by Osteopathic Medicine. R: Open to graduate-professional students in the College of Osteopathic Medicine.
