#### 883 Environmental Design Seminar

Fall, Spring. 3(3-0) Interdepartmental with Horticulture and Landscape Architecture and Park, Recreation and Tourism Resources. Administered by Horticulture. RB: Undergraduate design degree.

Examination of the breadth of environmental design projects. Literature review of focused projects. Development of practicum or thesis proposals.

#### 890B Supervised Independent Study in Apparel and Textiles

Fall, Spring, Summer. 1 to 6 credits. A student may earn a maximum of 9 credits in all enrollments for this course. R: Open to graduate students. Approval of department.

Independent study in topics related to apparel design, historic costume and textiles, museum collections, or human behavior, and ecological relations.

#### 891B Topics in Apparel and Textiles

Fall, Spring, Summer. 3(3-0) A student may earn a maximum of 6 credits in all enrollments for this course. R: Open to seniors in the Apparel and Textile Design major.

Selected topics related to apparel design, historic costume and textiles, museum collections, or human behavior, and ecological relations.

### 898 Master's Project

Fall, Spring, Summer. 1 to 4 credits. A student may earn a maximum of 8 credits in all enrollments for this course. R: Open to graduate students in the College of Arts and Letters.

Master's degree Plan B project. Participation in a project in apparel and textiles, interior design and human environment, or merchandising management

## 899 Master's Thesis Research

Fall, Spring, Summer. 1 to 7 credits. A student may earn a maximum of 20 credits in all enrollments for this course. R: Open to graduate students in the College of Arts and Letters.
